

Fire Safety at Work

This Basic Fire Safety training course trains participants to deal with fire on an emergency basis. It emphasises the danger of fire, the importance of prevention and the necessity of urgent action when fire breaks out.

On completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Describe the chemistry of fire.
- List the actions to be taken in the event of fire.
- State the organisations evacuation procedures.
- Evaluate and (if necessary and not life endangering) fight the fire with the correct extinguisher.
